YUMMY DOG BISCUIT RECIPE

Have fun making these treats for your dog.

Ingredients

21/4 cups whole wheat flour

½ cup powdered milk

1 egg

1/4 cup vegetable oil

1 beef bouillon cube

1 tablespoon brown sugar

½ cup hot water

Directions

Mix all ingredients until well blended. Knead dough for two minutes on a floured surface.

Roll dough to ¼ inch thickness.

Use a cookie cutter to cut biscuits.

Place biscuits on an ungreased cookie pan.

Bake 30 minutes in a 300-degree oven.

Let biscuits cool before giving to your dog!
